## Celebrating our impact in North Wales and North-West England

A milestone partnership since December 2024, D2 has made incredible strides in North Wales and North-West England. We have been proud to partner with our first North Wales Council with the aim of transforming homelessness support.

Our innovative approach is not only changing lives but also delivering substantial savings and providing local economic benefits.

Huge thanks to our amazing team for making this possible!

### Our achievements so far:

#### 14 HOUSES OPENED:

Since February 2025, we have opened 14 properties across this area.

#### 29 PEOPLE HOUSED:

We have provided homes for 29 individuals, prioritising single occupants, and keeping them close to communities.

#### 3 LOCAL JOBS CREATED:

We have hired 3 full time employees, fostering local talent and contributing to economic growth.

#### THOUSANDS SPENT LOCALLY:

We have invested thousands of pounds in businesses across the area, supporting the local economy and building strong community ties.

#### FIRST HMO APPROVAL:

We have successfully secured planning permission for our first 4 bedroom HMO, expanding our capacity to serve more people.

#### EXPANDING OUR REACH:

We have seen an increase in demand and are now servicing new departments, such as Children's Services.

This expanded collaboration reflects the trust we have earned, along with our ability to adapt, at pace, to evolving needs. With 40 bed spaces for single individuals and 10 for families in progress, complete with 24/7 on-call services and security, we are setting a new standard for compassionate, community-focused support.

### What's next?

Our work in North Wales and North-West England is just beginning. We are continuing to renovate properties, expand our HMO portfolio, and further strengthen our partnership with Local Authorities.
